COLOUR: LIGHTEST GOLD.

NOSE: SOFT SMOKY AROMAS WITH STEWED APPLE INITIALLY. SEA SALT AND DRIED HERBS DEVELOP AND COMBINE WITH A FLORAL LIGHTNESS. TOFFEE APPLE NOTES SUBTLY PERSERVERE BENEATH BONFIRE ASH AND ALL SPICE.

TASTE: SMOKE-CURED MEAT WITH A HINT OF CHILLI AND LEMON ZEST. BONFIRE EMBERS COMBINE WITH BLACK PEPPER AND A SOFT UNDERTONE OF RED BERRIES. A HINT OF DARK CHOCOLATE DEVELOPS.

FINISH: LONG AND LINGERING; LIGHT BONFIRE SMOKE WITH A CREAMY SPICE.
