**COLOUR:** LIGHTEST GOLD.

**NOSE:** RIPE APPLE AROMAS GIVE WAY TO SOFT *DESICCATED COCONUT* AND *VANILLA POD*. A HINT OF *CRYSTALLISED VIOLETS* COMBINE WITH SUBTLE *MALTED CEREAL*.

**TASTE:** SWEET AND SMOOTH FLAVOURS OF *TROPICAL FRUIT* AND *WALNUT*. *CITRUS ZEST* COMES TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE LIGHT *BLACK PEPPER* NOTES AND TOASTED *OAK*.

**FINISH:** A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH DELICATE SWEETNESS AND SOFT *SPICE*.
