**NOSE:** GRAPEFRUIT AND LIME AROMAS LEAD TO SOFT TOBACCO NOTES. DRIED BANANA COMES TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE HONEYSUCKLE AND MILK CHOCOLATE.

**TASTE:** SWEET FLAVOURS OF ORANGE PEEL AND ROASTED COFFEE BEANS GIVE WAY TO FRESH MINT. CRACKED BLACK PEPPER DEVELOPS TO LIGHT HERBAL NOTES.

**FINISH:** A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH LINGERING SPICE AND A SUBTLE HINT OF SMOKE.
