NOSE: SWEET AROMAS OF **BUTTERSCOTCH** AND **VANILLA** COMBINE WITH DRIED **RED APPLE** AND **WALNUT**. SUBTLE NOTES OF **LEMON AND LIME** DEVELOP ALONGSIDE **TOASTED OAK**.

TASTE: FLAVOURS OF **WHITE PEPPER** ARE FOLLOWED BY HINTS OF **LYCHEE** AND **CRYSTALLISED VIOLETS**. SWEET AND **CITRUS** NOTES OF **LEMON SHERBET** INTERTWINE WITH A HINT OF **OAK**.

FINISH: A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH SOFT **FLORAL** NOTES.
