COLOUR: DARK GOLD.

NOSE: SWEET *SHERRY* AROMAS COMPLEMENT AUTUMN *SPICES* AND TOASTED *HAZELNUT*. *ORANGE MARMALADE* NOTES DEVELOP, LEADING TO *BROWN SUGAR* AND SUBTLE *DRIED TOBACCO*.

TASTE: *STEWED RED BERRIES* GIVE WAY TO RICH *TOFFEE APPLES*. *CRACKED BLACK PEPPER* BALANCES THE PALATE AND LEADS TO *DARK TREACLE* AND MATURE *OAK*.

FINISH: A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH LINGERING NOTES OF *FRUITCAKE*.
