NOSE: *SHERRY* AROMAS GIVE WAY TO *MEDJOOOL DATES* AND *RED APPLE*. *FESTIVE SPICES* COME TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE *SEVILLE ORANGE ZEST* AND SWEET *SMOKE*.

TASTE: *STEWED RED BERRIES* COMBINE WITH FRESH *GINGER SPICE* AND SUBTLE *ANISEED*. TOASTED *ALMOND* UNDERTONES DEVELOP ACCOMPANIED BY *MINT*.

FINISH: A FULL AND LONG FINISH WITH LINGERING *SPICE*, *FRUIT* AND *BONFIRE EMBERS*.
