TASTE: SWEET *RASPBERRY* NOTES COMBINE WITH TOASTED *ALMONDS* AND *COCOA POWDER*. *CITRUS PEEL* DEVELOPS ACCOMPANIED BY *BAKED APPLE* AND *CLOVE*.

FINISH: A MEDIUM-BODIED FINISH WITH *SPICE* AND *FRUIT*.
