COLOUR: LIGHTEST GOLD.

NOSE: SWEET *POACHED PEAR* AND *PASSION FRUIT* COMBINE WITH FAINT NOTES OF *GRASS*. *HONEYSUCKLE* NOTES COME TO THE FORE ALONGSIDE SOFT *LEMON SHERBET* AND TOASTED *OAK*.

TASTE: SMOOTH *TROPICAL FRUITS* GIVE WAY TO *MIXED NUTS* AND *DARK HONEY*. SUBTLE *DESICCATED COCONUT* LEADS TO A HINT OF *ROSE WATER* AND *WHITE PEPPER*.

FINISH: MEDIUM-BODIED WITH *CITRUS ZEST*.
