COLOUR: DARK GOLD.

NOSE: RICH VANILLA AROMAS GIVE WAY TO NEW LEATHER AND A SUBTLE FLORAL NOTE. AN UNDERTONE OF TOFFEE DEVELOPS ALONGSIDE POACHED PEAR WITH A HINT OF FRESH CUT GRASS.

TASTE: DRYING OAK INITIALLY ON THE PALATE, LEADING TO A MOUTH-WARMING CHILLI WITH JUICY GRAPEFRUIT AND LEMON. FRESH FLAVOURS OF VIOLET LINGER THROUGHOUT WITH A HINT OF DRIED TOBACCO.

FINISH: MEDIUM-BODIED; SWEET
